Towards the Development of a Treatment as Prevention for HCV Strategy in British Columbia: A Longitudinal Cohort of Hepatitis C Patients who Achieved Sustained Virology Response

The Per-SVR study, pronounced "persevere", is a multi-year study of people who have been successfully treated for hepatitis C virus (HCV) using direct acting antivirals (DAAs). Conducted by the Principal Investigator Dr. Julio S.G. Montaner and the BC Centre for Excellence in HIV/AIDS, it is our hope that a better understanding of treatment experiences, HCV-reinfection, and health service use will lead to policies and services for those living with or at risk of HCV.

WHAT'S INVOLVED?

- Participants will be asked to attend around 10 visits. At each visit, there will be an interview and blood/urine testing
 - Following each visit, an honorarium will be offered

KEY ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 19 years or older
- - Currently on HCV treatment or finished treatment in the last 3 months
 - An undetectable viral load at end of HCV treatment
