ELIGIBILITY — PROVINCIAL LEVEL

Make an appointment at Disability Office at the Ministry of Development and Poverty Reduction or call 1-866-800-0800

- Ask for support to fill out the disability application. There are 2 reports:
 - 1. Physician's report, which must be fill out by your General Practitioner, or HIV Specialist.
 - 2. Social Worker's report, includes social aspect of your life



- Acknowledge you will wait 3 months while the Ministry makes a decision on your disability application
- © Get the designation as Senior or as Disabled person or person with multiple barriers. Give workers permission to access your personal and financial data
 - Open Federal file
- Check banking accounts
 Tax and tax returns
 Trust Funds


