## Overview of the SHAPE Study

The STOP HIV/AIDS Program Evaluation (SHAPE) study is a longitudinal cohort study of people living with HIV (PLWH) across British Columbia. The first phase of the study took place from 2016 to 2021 and captured healthcare experiences and outcomes, as well as retention across the HIV cascade of care among 644 people living with HIV (PLWH) across BC.

Following its conclusion, engagement with the community and the SHAPE steering committee identified a need to understand quality of healthcare, as well as health priorities and experiences of PLWH in order to adapt and improve health services in BC.

In August 2024 the second phase of the SHAPE study (SHAPE 2.0) was launched with the aim to assess the changing landscape of HIV services, aging, mental health, substance use, and chronic comorbidities that uniquely impact PLWH in BC.

#### SHAPE 2.0 is now recruiting participants!

Eligible people living with HIV can complete the survey online by themselves or with a peer interviewer over the phone or in-person. Get in touch to learn more!

#### Who is in our cohort?


From August 2024 to April 2025, a total of 641 participants have completed the survey.








Basic socio-demographic characteristics of the SHAPE 2.0 participant cohort (Aug 2024 - Apr 2025):
